Context

Recent analysis of the most recent Key Stage 5 data, indicates gaps in student's learning. Like many other educational institutions across the country, many of the student learning gaps can be attributed to the impact of the pandemic. The negative impact of the pandemic has affected all students and in particular students with specific vulnerabilities with Special Educational Needs, English as an Additional Language or from disadvantaged backgrounds.

We are a small 6th Form - 22% of students are resitting GCSE Mathematics and 16% are resitting GCSE English language. At present 8% of Year 13 students are at risk of not securing an acceptable passing grade in their A Level studies which could impact on their UCAS application. The subjects where some students are significantly underperforming and would need immediate intervention and support are:

- Philosophy
- History
- Health and Social Care
- Business Studies
- Applied Science
- Media Studies

In order to narrow the gaps in students' achievements we will seek to address these issues with targeted intervention.

How will the programme be delivered?

Intervention will include a more focused approach through: 1-1 sessions Small teaching group - 5 or less

The programme will be delivered on Saturdays on the school campus from 10am-2pm. These sessions will be delivered by special subject teachers in collaboration with external tutors where necessary.
