Before the examination series you are expected to:

- Check and read through the exam timetable carefully.
- Ensure that you are aware of any specialist equipment or resources you may require.
- Prepare a revision timetable in advance of the exams and stick to this.

During the examinations series you are expected to:

- Be punctual to registration and all lessons. You will be escorted to the Main Hall by your form tutor in the morning and by your class teacher after REC and lunch.
- You will leave your bags at the back of the Main Hall.
- Ensure any equipment required for the examination is taken out and any books and notes put into your bag.
- Ensure that any pencil case/s taken into the exam room are see-through.
- Enter the examination room in silence.
- Enter the room in an orderly manner, adhering to examination conditions and maintaining social distance.
- Candidates can wear their face covering on route to the Main Hall but you will not be allowed to wear these during their exam.
- Candidates will sanitise at the back of the Main Hall.
- Candidates will be given to a plastic bag to secure their face covering.
- Face masks should be taken off once candidates are seated.
- Ensure that you do not talk to or try to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once the exam has started.
- Ensure that you do not borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.
- Sit in the same seat for your examination. Do not move your exam desk.
- Toilet breaks will not be permitted in your examinations unless you have a medical exemption. Please make sure you use the toilet before school, at REC and Lunchtime.

At the end of the examination you are expected to:

- Stop writing as soon as a teacher indicates the time is up.
- Leave your examination paper on the desk.
- Ensure that your desk is left tidy for the next exam, handing in any spare papers and returning any equipment the department provided.
- Candidates will be dismissed **row by row**. Please form an orderly line at the back of the hall and wait to be escorted back to your teaching base by your class teacher.
- You will be dismissed via the back door leading to the green corridor - **not the fire exit**.
- If the examination finishes before the end of the designated session you will be taken back to your lessons.
