Your daughter may have already informed you about Elisa, one of our Year 11 students who escaped from a house fire, thankfully, with minor injuries.

However, her grandmother and grandfather were rushed into intensive care, suffering from burns and carbon monoxide poisoning. Her grandmother is still in intensive care and her uncle, who was also in her house, was taken to a specialist burns unit.

Elisa gave me her permission to use her name in this letter to you.

Elisa has lost everything including items of sentimental value that are irreplaceable. Her elderly grandparents have also lost everything.

Some of Elisa's school friends have been helping to buy her clothes and other essentials. On Friday 14 July, Paige and Amy, two Year 11 students shared the story with us in our assembly. This was done with the consent of Elisa.
