Dear Families

How quickly we have come to the end of another term and what a term it has been! We have kept you updated with all our news on our website. This is a longer letter than usual, I apologise in advance, but please keep reading to the end!

We break up for the Easter Holidays on Friday 31 March 2017. Dismissal for students will be at 12.50pm. The summer term begins on **Wednesday 19 April 2017** at the normal school time. Tuesday 18 April is a professional development day for staff. On our website you will find the dates for next term including when we break for the summer holidays, alongside the term and holiday dates, agreed by Governors, for next academic year (September 2017- July 2018).

Public examinations will begin in earnest within the first few weeks when we return. We will be thinking of our students in Years 11 to13 as they continue to study and take part in the revision programme over the Easter holidays. Although we want all those involved in examinations to take advantage of the all the revision that is on offer and work hard during the holiday, we also know that finding time for rest and relaxation is important and this should form part of their revision regime. The date for the first GCSE is Monday 15 May and the first A Level examination is on Wednesday 17 May. All students have already been issued with their examination timetable. I am sure that you will want to join me in sending best wishes to all of our young people who will be taking examinations this year and keep them in our prayers.

As part of our Lent focus we have taken part in the 40Acts Give Generously. Each day we have a whole school Lent challenge with an opportunity for reflection. As part of our Lent programme this year, in conjunction with Prayer Spaces for Schools, we set up a prayer space for three days. This was organised by Donna Akodu, a parent of a Year 9 student, who is a member of the St Martin's Parent Partnership. We thank her very much for all the work that went into setting this up and for arranging with members of Oasis Baptist Church and Holy Trinity Church to supervise the space during the three days. It was a blessing to have this room dedicated to prayer and spiritual growth.

As many schools up and down the country, we are affected by falling rolls. This, in turn, is impacting our funding. We are at a stage where we needed some expert input to support us with our marketing strategy. To this end, Governors and I have commissioned an Educational Marketing Consultancy to work with us. They will conduct a strategic review which will involve staff, students, governors, parents, primary schools and the local community. We will then use the outcomes to plan our marketing strategy. I will keep you updated about this.
