Service of Thanksgiving to celebrate 90 years in Tulse Hill at St Martin-in-the-Fields Church, Trafalgar Square, WC2N 4JJ - 10am on Wednesday 23rd May 2018

Ninety years ago St Martin-in-the-Fields High School for Girls moved from its location next to the church in Central London to its current location in Silwood House, Tulse Hill. We are going to mark this occasion and celebrate the proud history of our school by taking our whole school community to a service of thanksgiving in our founding church, St Martin-in-the-Fields in Trafalgar Square.
