Public examinations will begin in earnest within the first few weeks when we return. To support our students in Year 11 and in the sixth form we have a programme of revision that will take place during the two week holiday period. I am sure you want to join me in thanking all the members of staff that will give up some of their holiday, for no additional payment, to come into school to support the students at this very important time in their school career.

I am sure you will also want to join me in sending best wishes to all of our young people who will be taking examinations this year, we keep them in our prayers.

Building on the success of last year, Donna Akodu, a parent of a Year 10 student, who is also a member of the Parent Partnership has organised our school 'Prayer Space'. We thank her very much for all the work that has gone into planning and organising this hugely popular event, and to members of Oasis Baptist Church and Holy Trinity Church for supporting us by supervising in the 'Prayer Space' over three days.

I am delighted and excited to share the news with you that we have established a partnership with The Confucius Institute for Traditional Chinese Medicine (CITCM) at London South Bank University and, from April 2018, St Martin's will be an official Mandarin teaching site. The Institute will provide us with a full time Mandarin teacher and we will offer Mandarin lessons to our students, staff and parents. We will also set up some outreach with our primary schools. There will be many other benefits and a unique opportunity for our students to learn Mandarin, and participate in diverse cultural activities helping them develop a strong international awareness and cross cultural understanding.

- Curriculum Mandarin teaching to YCT HSK and GCSE
- Examination preparation
- Clubs and workshops
- Professional Chinese performances
- Chinese New Year roadshow
- Cultural Trips to China
- Scholarships to study in China
