RETURN TO SCHOOL NEXT WEEK

We are at the end of the summer holidays and are looking forward to seeing the students next week.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to navigate through all the guidance to make our school as safe as possible for everyone.

Please read to the end, again there will be a lot of information in this letter, some of which is a reminder, a lot of which is new information.

Risk Assessment, Visual Guidance, Family Handbook - Return to School Information

I hope you have had the opportunity to read these documents. It is very important that you do as it gives you a comprehensive understanding of the precautions we have taken to ensure the safety of everyone when school is reopened. The guidance was updated again on 26 August with the information on face coverings.

Face Coverings

On Tuesday 25 August 2020, the government amended its policy on face coverings in line with a new statement made by World Health Organisation (WHO) on 21 August advising that "children aged 12 and over should wear a mask under the same conditions as adults, in particular when they cannot guarantee at least a 1-metre distance from others and there is widespread transmission in the area."

The guidance also stipulates that face coverings are not recommended for the classroom, but schools have the discretion to require face coverings to be worn in communal areas if they believe that is right in their particular circumstances.

As we are a small school and the students have been grouped into bubbles, based in a classroom, movement in school will be extremely limited, there will be no requirement for students to wear face coverings at present.
