FACE COVERINGS... AGAIN!

I am repeating the information on face coverings as I really would like you to reinforce this to your child over the half term break. Already, over these three days since the government mandated that "face coverings must be worn by students and adults in communal areas outside the classroom", staff have had to spend too much time doing what I call 'Mask Management'.

We understand that some students are exempt, but the majority are not. We have shared with students several presentations on how to put on and remove and wear face coverings safely, including hand hygiene and the storage of face coverings. Some students are still choosing to wear them incorrectly or not at all. It is paramount for the safety and wellbeing of the St Martin's community and beyond, that the students adhere to this new and important expectation. Please ensure your child has at least two face coverings when they return after half term. See <u>face covering bulletin</u> and <u>half term letter</u> sent home this week.

After half term, if students are exempt, we will provide them with a blue badge that they can wear discreetly on their blazer. That way, if they are not wearing a face covering because of a health reason, they will not be asked.



Thank you for your continued support during this difficult and challenging time. The bubble structure will continue until further notice, which is not ideal, but it enables us to keep students separate to avoid mixing and potential spreading of the virus. The safety and wellbeing of all of us here at St Martin's is top priority.
